

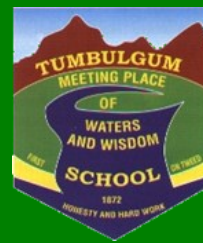

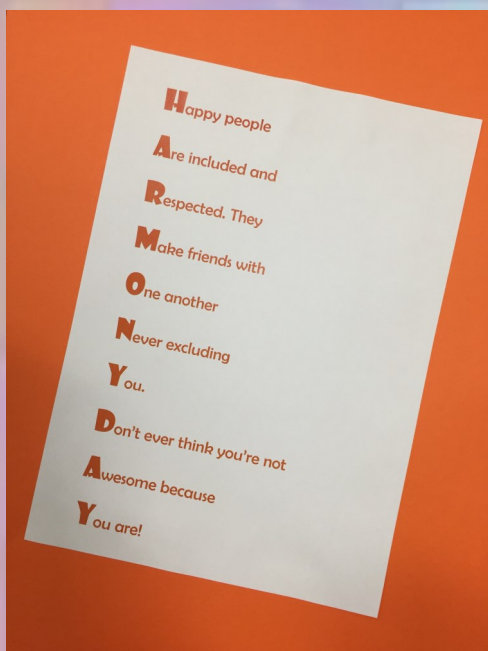
Rainbow Mufti Day—Harmony Day—Book Fair
