

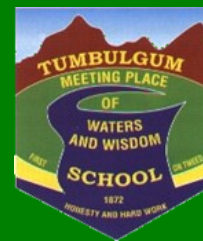

## Moran Photography Workshop

On Tuesday, Sally from Moran Photography in Sydney came to our school and she taught us about how to use a camera and how to take better photos. Sally showed us different techniques to use when taking a photo. One of the techniques was the rule of thirds where you can split the frame into thirds so that your object is not in the middle of the frame. Another technique was about the lighting in the background of a picture and how to adjust the colour to show different emotions.
