

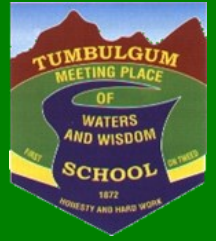

Cultural Garden

Our school community is currently working on developing a Cultural Garden in our school. The first stage which is the beautiful Aboriginal Mural has been completed.

The second stage of the project is a Bush Tucker Garden, which Kim (Kaida's mum) has been busy organising bush tucker plant donations from Tweed Shire Council which will enable each student to have a plant in our special garden. Thank you Kim!

The third stage of the project is the creation of a Yarning Circle. The use of a Yarning Circle is an important process within Aboriginal culture and Torres Strait Islander culture. It has been used by Indigenous peoples from around the world for centuries to learn from a collective group, build respectful relationships, and to preserve and pass on cultural knowledge..

The Yarning Circle will help to:

- encourage responsible, respectful and honest interactions between participants, building trusting relationships
- foster accountability and provide a safe place to be heard and to respond
- promote student-student interactions and student-school-community connectedness
- enrich learning experiences for students.
