

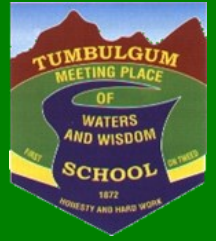

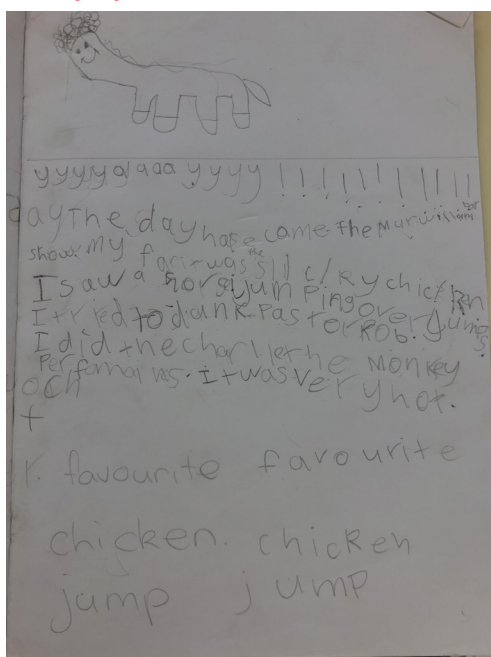
Murwillumbah Show
