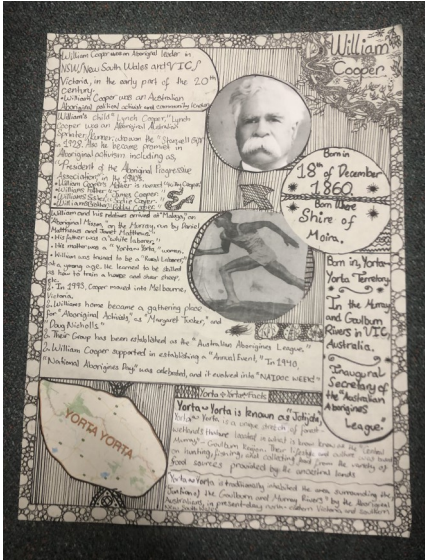

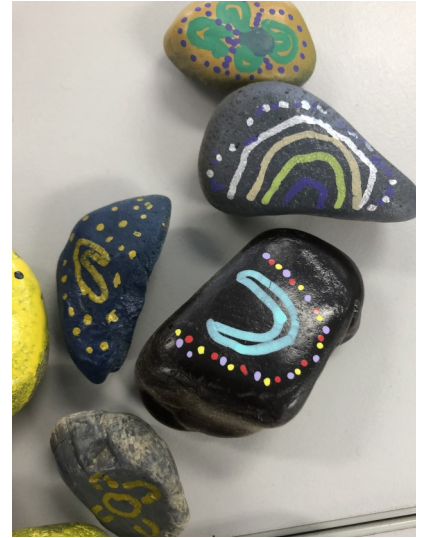
Students need a drink bottle as they cannot use the bubblers
