COVID 19 update

I understand as a parent that it is not easy when we request for your child to have a COVID test. Unfortunately there are times when this is essential to meet NSW Health guidelines to keep everyone safe.

We are required to ask for a negative test result when a student has even the mildest of COVID symptoms. These include fever, cough, runny nose, shortness of breath, sore throat, loss of smell, loss of taste, blocked nose, fatigue, muscle and joint pain, headache, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, loss of appetite, chest pain or conjunctivitis. This is true also of staff.

Thank you for keeping your distance at the school gate in the afternoon. This is great safe practice and making pick up time much safer.

This week, teachers have been using Seesaw to deliver lessons to your children and you will have seen some of these activities on their journal feed. At present, we are mostly focussing on making sure students are getting practice with some of the different formats Seesaw lessons can take and how these work on different devices. We are also ensuring all teachers are confident using this platform.

After School Care

As we are trying to get our staffing correct for afterschool care, could we please ask that you book your children in with at least one week's notice. Please consider that teachers are giving their own time for this program currently and I am concerned about the impact of the extra hours on their wellbeing.
