Term 3 COVID-safe guidelines

The Department of Education has issued new guidelines for schools. Here are the important points:-

- Students who test positive must not attend school until their isolation period ends and they are symptom free.
- Students who are close contacts must return a negative test daily for 5 consecutive days before attending school. The school should be notified if students' family members test positive to COVID-19.
- Stay home and get tested if unwell. Only attend school if symptom free.
- We will maintain good hygiene practices and maximise ventilation.
- We will also provide families with RAT kits—which are especially important for daily testing of close contacts. If you are requiring more, please ask.
- Please remember that positive RAT results must be registered with Service NSW.
- Keeping up to date with vaccinations—COVID and flu—will reduce the risk across our community.
