#### Flood Recovery Updates

Tumbulgum Public School suffered extensive damage as a result of the flood events in February and March 2022, with floodwater entering the school and damaging buildings on site.

Students are currently learning in a temporary demountable school at Tumbulgum Public School. Tumbulgum Public School is considered a high flood evacuation risk by the SES and Tweed Shire Council have expressed concerns about a new school being built back on the existing site.

In the interim, Tumbulgum Public School will have sections of the existing flood impacted school refurbished.



#### PAX & Behaviour


As you know, we have introduced PAX The Good Behaviour Game to support a peaceful classroom environment supporting learning, wellbeing, participation and confidence. As PAX is a big part of our school day, it is important for us to share some of its concepts to help promote its overall success. Over the next few weeks, we will be introducing you to some of the aspects of PAX. Today, I would like to share with you some information about Tootles and how we use these to promote positive behaviours here at Tumbulgum.





#### **Tootles**

Tootles are the opposite of tattles. Tootling is looking for the positive actions and telling them or others about the actions. Scientists have shown that tootles improve behaviour, character, and social competence and reduce aggression or bullying in schools. Your child will receive a Tootle Note when they display an outstanding or repeated positive behaviour. If your child receives a Tootle for that week, it will be presented by the classroom teacher on Fridays and added to the classroom chart. They will then be able to bring them home and share their success with you.



## **Tumbulgum Tootles Reward System**

Next week, we are introducing the Tumbulgum Tootles reward system. Each time your child receives a Tootles, it gets recorded on a Tootles classroom chart and children can work towards their Tumbulgum Tootles Rewards.

#### **Enrolments**





#### **Tumbulgum Public School**

Project update | May 2023

#### What is happening at Tumbulgum Public School?

A project is underway to rebuild Tumbulgum Public School after it was damaged by floods in early 2022. Students will remain in their temporary demountable school until a long-term solution is finalised.

#### **Current status**

Tumbulgum Public School is considered a high flood evacuation risk by the SES and Tweed Shire Council have expressed concerns about a new school being built on the existing site.

Tumbulgum Public School will have sections of their existing school refurbished, as an interim solution.

#### **Next steps**

SINSW Asset Management Unit (AMU) have commenced the scope and will developed a timeline for refurbishment works of the flood damaged school.

Students will then move into their refurbished school at Tumbulgum Public School.

A commitment to rebuild Tumbulgum Public School in the long term remains. SINSW continues to seek advice from the NRRC relating to the rollout of their various housing program strategies to ensure our school infrastructure meet the long-term needs of the community, the SES and Tweed Shire Council.
